MADRAMS adopts the MAAA manual of procedures. All pilots must comply with all MAAA MOPs and Civil Aviation Safety Regulations. A copy of the MAAA manual is available on the Club website.

Club By Laws

1. To fly at MADRAMS you must be a current financial member.
2. Models must be operated in a safe responsible manner at all times
3. The club will allow current visiting MAAA members to fly at the field under the following conditions. The visitor must produce a current MAAA affiliated licence which covers MAAA insurance conditions. The visitor book must be filled out by the visitor and a current member.
4. Prospective members may be signed into the visitor's book on 4 occasions, before required to join the club.
5. Flying is permitted at MADRAMS between Sunrise and sunset, Monday to Sunday for all quiet electric models, flying for large electric and combustion engine models is permitted between 8AM and sunset, Monday to Saturday and 9am to sunset Sunday.
6. All vehicles must be properly parked and must not be driven past the tree line/ pit area.
7. For the purpose of model retrieval, gates to access the adjoining property must be used. Do not climb over the fence.
8. Take-offs/Landings are not permitted from taxiways or pit area.
9. Engines must only be started in the Pit area (facing away from any parking areas or club house and be properly restrained).
10. Where an FPV flight is being conducted there must be a safety pilot observer with the pilot.

11. The last member to leave the field must ensure that all buildings and gates are securely locked.

12. Flying boundaries must be strictly observed. See site map on building for Pilot Bay and engine run up zones, no fly zones.

14. Any accident involving the operation of model aircraft which results in injury to another person/s and/or damage to another's property shall be reported to a person in the management committee immediately.

15. No person shall operate any model aircraft at the field while a working bee is in progress.

16. No person shall fly any radio-controlled model after having consumed any alcoholic beverage or used any drug to an extent which is likely to impair such persons ability to control a model safely.

17. Pets are allowed at Madrams but must be restrained at all times. The person responsible for the pet must ensure that it stays clear of all operational areas and suitable distances from other members and visitors

18. Only persons flying, being instructed or otherwise directly involved with a particular flight are to be in the pilot area
